- **Characteristics:** Golden brown color, straight grain, natural oils that enhance durability and water resistance.
- **Uses:** High-end furniture, boat decks, flooring, and outdoor furniture.



• Origin: West Africa

• Characteristics: Golden to medium brown, coarse texture, less oily than Asian teak, but highly durable.

• Uses: Outdoor furniture, flooring, and general construction.





- **Origin:** Various tropical regions, including Central and South America, Africa, and Asia.

- Uses: Furniture, flooring, and paneling.





### 2. Wood Seasoning



- Naturally drying the wood or using a kiln to reduce its moisture content to around 6-8%. This prevents warping and cracking.
- Storing the seasoned wood in a dry, wellventilated area until it's ready for use.

### 3. Cutting The Wood



- Dimensions of the door opening are measured to decide on the width, thickness, and height of the frame.
- The seasoned wood is cut with precision to the required dimensions using a saw.
- The locations for joints and hinges on the cut pieces are marked.

### 4. Planing & Shaping



- Using a planer to smooth the cut pieces of wood, ensuring all surfaces are even and flat.
- Shaping the edges of the frame pieces if needed, using a router to create decorative profiles or bevels.

### 5. Assembling The Frame



- Creating the necessary joints for assembling the frame including mortise and tenon, lap joints, or dowel joints.
- Assembling the frame using wood glue & clamps to ensure a tight fit. Also, Reinforcement of the joints with screws or nails is done for added strength.

### 6. Sanding & Finishing



- Sanding the assembled frame to remove any rough spots, ensuring a smooth finish.
- Doing polishing & lamination to protect the wood and enhance its appearance.

### 7. Polishing & Painting



- Applying a high-quality primer to enhance paint adhesion and durability.
- Using premium wood polish to bring out the natural grain and provide a protective layer.
- Offering a wide range of paint colors and finishes to match your style preferences.
- Ensuring an even, flawless finish with meticulous attention to detail and quality control.

### 8. Fitting The Frame



- Positioning the frame in the door opening, using shims to ensure it is level and plumb.
- Securing the frame to the wall study using long screws or nails through the sides of the frame.
- Filling any gaps between the frame and the wall with insulation foam or backer rod to prevent drafts.

### 9. Final Adjustments



- Adjusting the hinges if necessary to ensure the door opens and closes smoothly without binding.
- Applying caulk around the edges of the frame where it meets the wall to seal any gaps.
- Trimming or molding around the frame for a finished look, nailing it securely and filling any nail holes with wood filler.
